The uniform fees for services provided by the Fire Districts of Manatee County shall be in full force and effect for any District who Formally adopts this schedule by resolution.

### 1 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the reviews of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Emergency Fire Apparatus Access:
  - Roadways
  - Turnarounds
  - Emergency Access/Fire Lanes
  - Automatic Gates that do not require a building permit
- Water Supply Requirements:
  - Hydrants
  - Minimum Flow Requirements
- Fire Sprinkler/Standpipe Requirements
  - Point of Service
  - Backflow Devices
  - Fire Department Connection (FDC)

This will include, but not be limited to the review of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Building:
  - New Construction<sup>b</sup>
  - Renovations<sup>b</sup>
  - Remodels<sup>b</sup>
- Demolition<sup>e</sup>
- Tents<sup>e</sup>
- Temporary Use<sup>e</sup>

### 3 FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the review of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Fire Sprinkler Systems:
  - Underground<sup>d</sup>
  - Aboveground<sup>c</sup>
- Other Suppression Systems:
  - Cooking/Hood<sup>d</sup>
  - Fire pump/Standpipe<sup>d</sup>
  - Clean Agent<sup>d</sup>
- Fire Alarm System<sup>c</sup>

### 4 <u>CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY RELATED SERVICES</u>

This will include, but not be limited to the final inspections of the following in order to receive a Certificate of Occupancy (CO) by Manatee County:

- Compliance with approved plans
- Fire Protection Systems documentation
- Life safety features
- Exit and emergency lighting
- Egress systems
- Fire extinguishers
- Addressing numbers
- Rapid entry Systems

b	Each re-inspection of a failed initial CO final inspection	\$150
c	Occupancy prior to issuance of a CO (in addition to re-inspection fees)	\$500

#### 5 FIREWORKS AND PYROTECHNICS RELATED SERVICES\*

This will include, but not be limited to the plans, permits, inspections and standby for:

- On-going fireworks/pyrotechnics related permitting
  - Storage
  - Product Testing
- Public fireworks displays by a licensed pyrotechnic
  - Indoor
  - Outdoor

<sup>\*</sup> The Fire Marshal may waive the fee for all publicly noticed fireworks displays which are printed prior to the display in a daily or weekly newspaper and/or a minimum of 3 days prior in an associated newspapers' website for the benefit of the general public which does not constitute an undue burden on the District. Per Florida Statute 791.08(1), private citizen displays not advertised as noted above would also be exempt from the fee on Independence Day (July 4<sup>th</sup>), New Years Eve (December 31<sup>st</sup>) and New Years Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>). Nothing herein exempts any person, municipality, or business from obtaining the proper authorization from the Fire Marshal prior to the display to the display of fireworks at any time.





### 6 STANDBY SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the provision of Fire District personnel and equipment for:

- Required standbys:
  - Fire Watch
  - Incidents
  - Events
- Requested Standbys
- a Equipment costs Current F.E.M.A. Schedule of Equipment Rates
- b Personnel cost per Fire District employee pay and benefits rates
- c Supply cost the actual replacement cost for any supplies

### 7 FALSE ALARMS

This will include, but not be limited to the following types of false alarms:

- Malfunction
- Nuisance alarms

b	False alarm fee 4-5	\$100.00
c	False alarm fee 6-7	\$250.00
d	False alarm fee 8+	\$500.00
